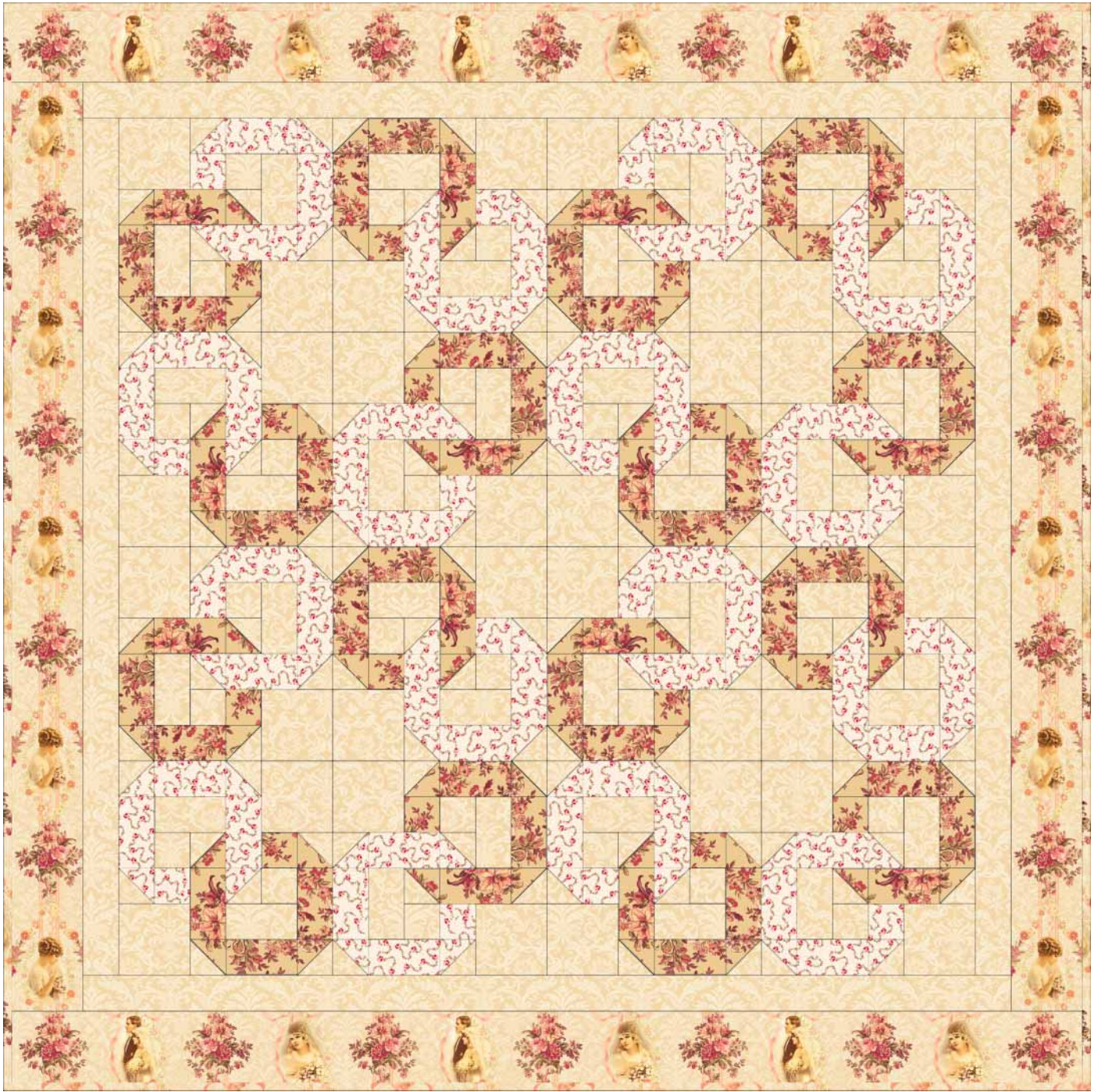

### Cutting

#### Background and Background Border (25575-E)

- 4- 2 1/2" x 42" strips
- 32 - 2 1/2" squares
- 32 - 4 1/2" squares
- 64 - 2 7/8" squares (draw diagonal line corner to corner on wrong side)
- 2 - 2 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips (sides)
- 2 - 2 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips (top & bottom- will be pieced)



#### Light Rings (22571-E)

- 2 - 2 1/2" x 42" strips
- 16 - 2 1/2" squares
- 32 - 2 7/8" squares
- 32 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" pieces

#### Dark Rings (22573-E)

- 2 - 2 1/2" x 42" strips
- 16 - 2 1/2" squares
- 32 - 2 7/8" squares
- 32 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" pieces

#### Outside Border and Binding (25569-E)

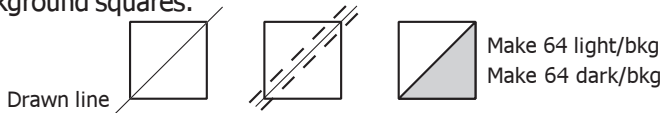
- \*\*Cut SIDE border lengths parallel to selvages
- 2 - 4 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips (sides) See above \*\*.
- 2 - 4 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips (top & bottom - will be pieced)
- 245" - 2 1/2" x 42" strip for binding (will be pieced)

### Sewing

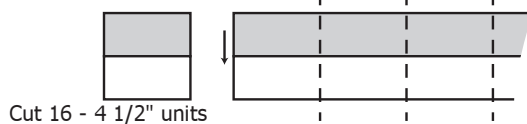
Seam allowances are standard 1/4".

Arrows indicate pressing direction.

- RST, pair up 2 7/8" light ring squares with 2 7/8" background squares. Sew 1/4" each side of drawn line. Cut apart on drawn line and press to background. Makes 64 half-square triangle units. Repeat for 2 7/8" dark ring and background squares.

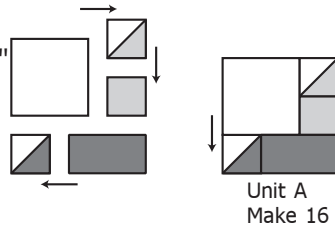


- RST, sew light ring 2 1/2" x 42" strips and background strips together lengthwise. Press to background. Cut into 16 - 4 1/2" units, Repeat for dark ring 2 1/2" strips and background strips.

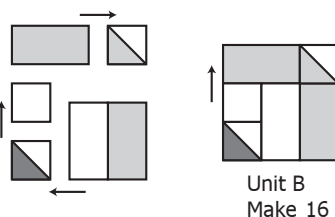


### Making the Units

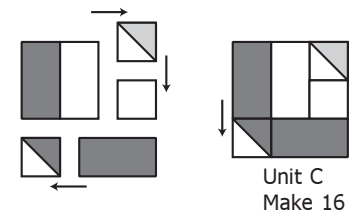
- Sew light triangle unit to 2 1/2" light ring square. Sew to 4 1/2" background square. Sew dark triangle unit to 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" piece, then sew to top of unit. This completes Unit A. Make 16.



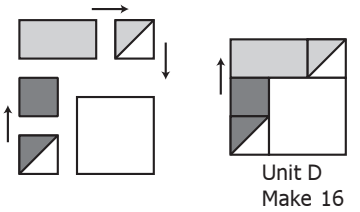
- Sew light 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" piece to light triangle unit. Sew 2 1/2" background square to dark triangle unit and sew to 4 1/2" light strip piece unit. Add this to light bottom of unit. This completes Unit B. Make 16.



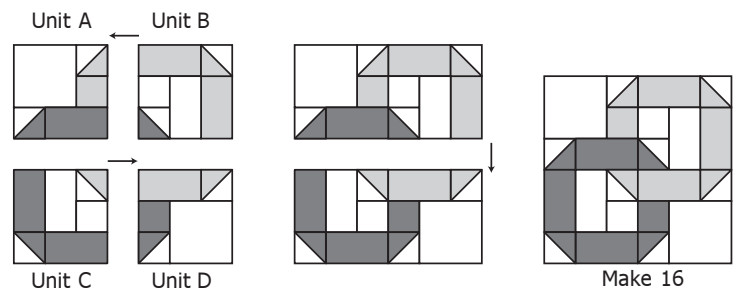
- Sew light triangle unit to 2 1/2" background square. Sew to 4 1/2" dark strip piece unit. Sew dark triangle unit to 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" dark piece. Add this to top of unit. This completes Unit C. Make 16.



- Sew 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" piece to light triangle unit. Sew 2 1/2" dark square to dark triangle unit. Then, sew this to 4 1/2" background square. Sew this to bottom of unit. This completes Unit D. Make 16.

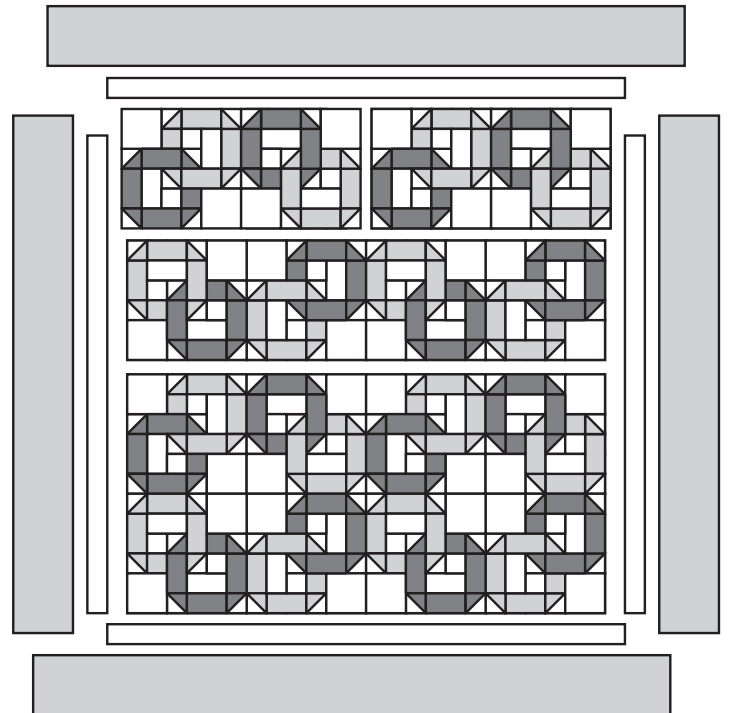


- Join one Unit A to Unit B and Unit C to Unit D. Join A/B to C/D. Make 16 Blocks.



- Using illustration below for layout, join 4 blocks together in a row. Make 4 rows. Join rows together.

- Add background borders and outside borders. Sides first, then, top and bottom.



- Layer, quilt and bind.
